

The Army Benefits Center – Civilian (ABC-C) Offers CSRS and FERS Benefits Overview via DCO

Did you know...

The Army Benefits Center – Civilian (ABC-C) conducts retirement benefits overview briefings via Defense Connect Online (DCO) for Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS)/CSRS Offset and Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS). DCO allows an employee to participate in web conferencing and meeting from their computer/workstation.

The DCO briefing sessions are at no cost/tuition and lasts about 4 hours each. Generally the CSRS briefings are scheduled for the morning session, and the FERS briefings are scheduled for the afternoon session.

The DCOs are usually scheduled once a month. Please click [here](#) to view the ABC-C schedule for the current fiscal year.

The target audiences for these briefings are employees who are within 5 to 15 years of retirement eligibility.
