

The Army Benefits Center – Civilian (ABC-C) Conducts CSRS and FERS Benefits Overview via VTT

Did You Know...

The Army Benefits Center – Civilian (ABC-C) conducts retirement benefits overview briefings via Video Tele-Training (VTT) for these audiences: Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS)/CSRS Offset and Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS).

The briefings sessions are at no cost/tuition and lasts about 4 hours each. Generally the CSRS briefings are scheduled for the morning session, and the FERS briefings are scheduled for the afternoon session.

Depending on the space available at your organization's site, the target audiences for these briefings are employees who are within 10 to 15 years of retirement eligibility. If space is at a premium, priority should be given to those who are within 5 years of retirement.
