

USAJOBS Downtime Notice

How Will the USAJOBS Downtime Affect You?

On 1 Oct 11, the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) will assume control of USAJOBS. USAJOBS is the government's official site for posting vacancy announcements and hiring information. To make this happen, the system will be taken offline for a short period of time to ensure appropriate modifications are enabled and functioning properly. The changes are designed to alleviate some of the bottlenecks experienced when requesting system updates, e.g., adding new USAJOBS Search Locations.

Significant dates:

26 Sep thru 10 Oct - Announcements opened prior to 26 Sep may remain open through the moratorium period but must not close before 10 Oct.

1-7 Oct - USAJOBS will be offline and no-one will be able to see posted announcements or apply for federal jobs, e.g., job applicants, staffers, etc.

Most changes to USAJOBS will be transparent to job seekers and staffers. OPM will be posting notices on USAJOBS concerning the downtime.
