## WHMC pediatric services move to BAMC

The majority of Wilford Hall Medical Center pediatric services will move to Brooke Army Medical Center in April as part of the BRAC process.

“These changes support BRAC law to move all Wilford Hall inpatient care to BAMC and will provide continued quality care to our beneficiaries,” said Col. (Dr.) Mary Pelszynski, commander, 59th Maternal/Child Care Squadron.

The pediatric ward and pediatric intensive care unit are scheduled to move to the fifth floor of BAMC the week of April 19, opening for admissions on April 26. This will be the first time that BAMC has housed these departments.

The majority of WHMC pediatric subspecialty clinics are also scheduled to move to the fifth floor of BAMC that same week, including Endocrinology, Gastrointestinal, Hematology/Oncology, Pulmonary, Nephrology, Child Neurology, Infectious Disease and Pediatric Surgery.

There will be no appointments scheduled during the move with all clinics planning to reopen for business on April 26.

The WHMC Pediatric Cardiology and Genetics main outpatient clinics will remain in their current locations at Lackland Air Force Base. The Pediatric Wellness Center will also remain at WHMC.

Adolescent Medicine and Developmental Pediatric Clinics will exist at both hospitals. Inpatient services for all pediatric clinics will be provided at BAMC.
