



CAMP BULLIS SMOKING RESTRICTIONS :

- **Smoking is prohibited in the training areas at Camp Bullis.** This includes all areas beyond the Range Control gate, with the following exceptions: Units with permanent fixed facilities may establish designated smoking areas within the confines of those facilities. These include the Soldier Medic Training Site, FOB Warrior, DEMSET, Medical Readiness Training Center, INSCOM Detention Training Facility, TAC-SIMM, Officer Basic Course, Camp Anderson-Peters and the CACTF. The designated smoking area must be in a location that is free of vegetation, and must be within the confines of the facility. A fire extinguisher must be in place.
- **Units and individuals utilizing Camp Bullis Training Sites or Training Areas are prohibited from establishing designated smoking areas, and are prohibited from allowing their unit members to smoke.** This includes individuals who may be in the training areas for recreational purposes, such as hunting.
- **Smoking is prohibited in the Camp Bullis Cantonment Area, except in designated smoking areas.**
- **Smoking is prohibited in all vehicles, both government and privately owned, in all areas.**
